★ Welcome to Reading Fair season at WES! The goal of the reading fair is to give our
★ students a chance to share one of their favorite books with the rest of the school in a creative
★ way. The Reading Fair also gives students an opportunity to demonstrate their knowledge of
★ the parts of a book and the components of a story.

★ The projects also receive a test grade for their Reading Fair Project. For those unfamiliar
★ with Reading Fair, the fair is a chance for students to display information about a book they
★ have read. These displays are presented on trifold boards. The information can be typed or
★ handwritten. Winning projects are often those with bright, colorful, and neat illustrations and
★ words. Students will have help from their teachers with choosing a book. It may be nonfiction
★ or fiction. The book should be one that the student can read in a relatively short time (in order
★ to meet the due date).
